DIRECTIONS & PARKING:

The 1719 William Trent House is located on the corner of William Trent Place and Market Street, across from the Hughes Justice Complex.

- From Route 29 North or South, exit at Market Street. Turn right onto William Trent Place at the light. Park in the lot adjacent to the museum grounds.

- From Route 1 South: Follow U.S. Route 1 South to the Warren Street exit (marked last exit before toll) At the light go straight through the parking lot. At the stop sign the Trent House will be straight ahead.

- From Route 1 North: Follow U.S. Route 1 North to the Route 29/Lamberville exit, which is the first exit in New Jersey after you cross the Delaware River. Go straight through the yield and then bear right at the traffic signal, onto Route 29 North. Take the Market Street exit. Make the first right onto William Trent Place.
